3. Terms of Reference

3.1 **To consider and advise the Board of Governors on**

- 1. Nominees for appointment as Governors, for recommendation to the Governance and Nominations Committee, as follows:
 - One (1) person from the four (4) Diocesan Nominees nominated to the membership of the Foundation Committee by the Bishop of Leeds or the Archbishop of York
 - Two (2) persons who are members of the Church of England or a church in communion with it.

Under Article 8.2.2, the Committee must make such recommendations for consideration to the Governance and Nominations Committee by 14 June of the relevant year.

2. The development of the University's values

3.2 To be responsible, on behalf of the Board of Governors, for:

- a) Considering practical strategies for promoting dialogue about spiritual, moral, social and cultural issues to existing and potential members of the University community, associated partners and the wider society.
- b) Consulting and communicating in order to explore the impact and meaning for a diverse student and staff community, of belonging to a University with a church foundation.
- c) Considering and recommending to Academic Board, any changes to the University's ethics policy and framework.

- d) Receiving reports on the following:
 - The activities of the Chaplaincy (at least annually)
 - Theology and Religious Studies academic activity (annually)
 - The activities of the Students' Union's faith societies (annually)
 - Student data on faith (annually)
 - Relevant social innovation projects

3.3 To refer to

Other committees (e.g., committees of the Board of Governors, Academic Board, Executive Board), any relevant matters for consideration.

3.4 **Delegated responsibilities**

The Committee does not routinely delegate any categories of business.

4 **Procedural rules**

4.1 Quorum

Eight (8) members at least three (3) of whom must be independent Governors.

4.2 Meetings

The Committee shall meet two (2) times a year, unless otherwise agreed by the Committee Chair.

4.3 Agenda

The agenda shall be the responsibility of the Committee Chair and the Committee shall be serviced by the Secretary or nominee who shall normally provide the agenda and supporting papers seven (7) days prior to the meeting.

5 **Reporting**

The unreserved minutes (or a report) of meetings of the Committee will be circulated to all members of the Board of Governors.
