

These short-term global opportunities start from just 1 week and are available for all students on any degree.

Volunteer with Think Pacific

Think Pacific is a UK social enterprise and registered Fijian charity, which works with local government partners to achieve ethical, responsible and sustainable development in remote Fijian communities, whilst allowing university students to have a structured and rewarding experience. On a 16 day or one-month team expedition, international volunteers live at the heart of a Fijian village, experience challenges, teamwork and cultural differences and work side-by-side with Fijian youths to discuss, explore and implement sustainable projects to tackle a range of social issues. Anyone can complete any expedition although some may compliment specific degrees.

Think Pacific – Fiji Mental Health Project 2022

An incredible opportunity that I would highly recommend to everyone! I was warmly welcomed into a local Fijian household and allowed to experience

Fijian culture at its more raw moments, in the heart of a traditional village. I facilitated workshops on mental health, alongside local mental health practitioners, educating and raising awareness of what is such a taboo topic in Fiji. We witnessed the locals and ourselves develop an understanding of mental health at a deeper level and open up about their experiences, whilst we provided information on services that exist in Fiji. This was such an eye-opening experience that I never believed I would be capable of doing. I made friends for life, learned new things about myself and witnessed with my own eyes the positive change I helped to make.







Work in Summer Camps (USA)

An All-American tradition, between June and August each year over a million children and teenagers attend summer camps in America for between 1-8 weeks as Camp Counsellors and Activity Specialists.

With over 10,000 camps, there are thousands of summer camp roles and camp vacancies open for international applicants – from working with young people with disabilities, to running crafts and teaching sports.

We partner with organisations (CCUSA, USA Summer Camp, and BUNAC) who provide camp opportunities in the USA. With these opportunities, you can travel to the US to gain experience working with children whilst earning an income.

Camp America





Where can I go?

Portugal or Vietnam

What opportunities are available?

(unpaid) internships in your chosen destination, sector and host company. We will sponsor two students for this programme (please see funding section below for more information on eligibility).

How long is it?

8 weeks (4 weeks online and 4 weeks inperson)

Funding

Fundraising for Volunteering Programmes

We encourage students to fundraise for volunteering programmes to contribute/ pay for programme fees.

It can be daunting to think about the amount of money you may need to fundraise for your overseas opportunity, but we and your organisation are here to support you every step of the way in achieving your goals!

Here's how to get started:

- Book an appointment through Handshake with the Global Opportunities team where we can discuss your support needs and realistic fundraising plans.
- Contact the organisation that you're fundraising for, most organisations have fundraising advisors who can help you with planning and ideas.

What can I do?

Make the most of your university community!

- Contact your Students' Union who can help you to organise pub quizzes and events
- Ask Societies to sponsor you
- Organise bakes sales and activities to take place on campus

Common fundraising ideas include:

- · Raffles
- Bake sales
- Crowdfunding
- 100 square bingo

I raised £1300 for my summer opportunity in 2022 through crowdfunding, a raffle, and 100 square bingo. My advice would be to get the word out and be proud of what you are doing, you will be surprised at who is willing to support you.

YSJU International Volunteering Fund

At York St John University we want to give all students the opportunity to have life changing experiences through international volunteering opportunities. It may be that you are wanting to undertake a shorter 2-week opportunity, or you don't meet the personal criteria for Turing Funding. The YSJ International Volunteering Fund exists to support those who are not eligible for Turing Funding and can help you achieve your fundraising goal or support with living costs whilst you are volunteering overseas.

More information on the YSJ International Volunteering Fund will be released from January 2024.



Turing Scheme Funding

The Turing Scheme is the UK government's programme to provide funding for international opportunities in education and training across the world. York St John University have a limited number of spaces available for eligible students on projects for Summer 2024. In this leaflet you can see what projects qualify for funding.




The Turing scheme prioritises the following groups for funding:

- Students with an annual household income of £25,000 or less
- Students who have caring responsibilities
- · Care leavers and students who are care experienced
- · Estranged students

Deadline for funding application:

Apply to us for Turing funding between November 1st-15th.

What may I be eligible for if I qualify for Turing Funding?

You will receive a monthly cost of living grant, as well as a travel grant. You may also have essential costs, such as visa, insurance and medicals refunded. Any costs associated with SEND may also be refunded.


