KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS BY 2026

By 2026 we will have:

- Almost double the number of PGRs.
- 50% of PGRs from underrepresented groups.
- 85% overall satisfaction in Postgraduate Research Experience Survey.
- 95% PGR continuation (year-to-year).
- 80% PGR completion (cohort-to-cohort).
- 85% PGR employment in skilled jobs after 12 months of completion.
