Information Guide



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Introduction

The following guide is for graduands attending the November 2026 ceremonies at York Minster. This guide provides everything you need to know about your graduation ceremony, including how to book your attire, register your attendance, what to do on the day and answers to frequently asked questions.

Academic congregations will be held to celebrate the conferral of degrees and awards upon students at the University who have successfully completed their studies and had their award conferred at the School Assessment Board (SAB) between September 2025 and August 2026.

1. Ceremony dates

The York graduation ceremonies will be taking place at York Minster on the week commencing 16th November 2026.

A personalised invitation confirming the date of your ceremony will be sent all eligible graduates. We advise against booking travel or accommodation until you have received your official invitation.

2. The Booking Portal

2.1 How to Confirm Your Attendance

An invitation to your graduation ceremony has been sent to your personal and/or home email address. Please make sure your contact details are up to date via the e:Vision homepage.

If you have not received your invitation or you have changed your contact details recently, please let us know by contacting graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk as soon as possible.

Your invitation will contain instructions that detail how to confirm your attendance. You will need to register your attendance by no later than **4:00pm (BST) Wednesday 30th September 2026**. Please read the following information carefully, using your personal email address to register/order, and being sure you do not miss any of the deadlines.

Please note, graduates do not need to purchase a guest ticket for themselves, by booking your robes and attire you have confirmed your attendance. Guest tickets are to be purchased for guests only.

Your own seat number in the Minster will be on your e-ticket which will be emailed to you around a week before the ceremony, along with your guest tickets. Please ensure that you give your guests their tickets as these will be checked on entry to the Minster.

If you experience any technical issues with ordering your tickets and /or gown, please contact the dedicated customer service department at Grad Attire on service@graduationattire.co.uk or use the chatbot function on their [website](#).

2.2 Can I Defer My Attendance?

It is University policy that attendance at graduation ceremonies cannot normally be deferred; you are expected to attend the ceremony following completion of your award.

Deferral **may** be permitted if genuine circumstances prevent you from attending your ceremony. For example, this could be due to medical reasons but not because of holidays or prior engagements.

If you wish to request a deferral you must contact the Graduation Team at graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk before the date of your ceremony, requests to defer need to be submitted with explanation before the original ceremony has taken place. All deferral requests will need to be reviewed by management and are subject to approval.

2.2 Guest tickets

Guest tickets will be available for purchase through our online booking portal. Your invitation will contain instructions that detail how to purchase guest tickets. You will need to purchase your guest tickets by **no later than 4:00pm (BST) Wednesday 30th September 2026**.

Guest tickets **must** be ordered before the ceremony. Guests cannot access the online booking portal; all guest tickets must be purchased by the graduate.

Once the booking portal opens you will be able to purchase a maximum of **two** guest tickets, at £10.00 per ticket. This is to ensure each graduate is given equal opportunity to purchase two guest tickets.

2.4 Extra Guest Tickets

Our guest tickets are initially capped at two per graduate, this is to ensure each graduate is given equal opportunity to purchase two guest tickets. All guest tickets must be purchased via our online booking portal; these will be available for purchase alongside attire, photography packages etc.

Further tickets may become available in mid-October – **you will be contacted if this is the case.**

Once the booking deadline has arrived and the portal closes, we then assess how many extra tickets we can offer per ceremony. We cannot guarantee that extra tickets will be made available at any point, and if these are made available, these are sold on a first-come first-served basis. How many we will be able to offer depends on the size of each ceremony.

Emails will be sent out by the University to notify you when/if these extra tickets are available. Additional guest tickets will be charged at £10.00 per ticket.

We are unable to reserve extra tickets on anyone's behalf or confirm the availability of any additional tickets before 7th October 2026 so please do not contact us about additional guest tickets before this date as we will not be in a position to process your request.

If any of your guests are no longer able to attend, please let us know by emailing graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk. This will allow us to release tickets to others in your ceremony.

2.5 Lost or Missing Tickets

Graduate and guest e-tickets will be issued via email by the GradAttire online booking system week commencing 9th November 2026. If you have not received your graduate and/or guest tickets by Friday 13th November your tickets may be filtered into your spam/junk folder, please check this folder. If you have not received your graduate and/or guest ticket to your main inbox or junk folder please contact the **Graduation team before** the day of your ceremony.

Please print out or download onto a mobile device and bring all tickets with you on the day as they will be checked and verified by staff on entry to the Minster. If you have any problems downloading your tickets or do not receive them, please contact the **Graduation team before** the day of the ceremony.

2.6 Order Amendments and Refunds

If you have made a mistake with the size of your gown or cap, you should not worry as we can simply update this so that it is a smooth process on the day.

Anything you have already paid for will require changes to be made manually over the phone. This would include changing the gown day hire to an extended hire, or even purchase.

If you can no longer attend the ceremony and require a refund please first contact graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk to inform us of this change. You will then need to contact the Grad Attire's customer service

department via service@graduationattire.co.uk to request the cancellation of your booking and refund of funds. In order to claim full return of your payment you must submit the refund request before **9th November 2026**. Grad Attire's refund policy can be found [here](#).

The University works hard to ensure that the Graduation ceremonies are enjoyable and celebratory, and as they are non-profit making, we cannot issue late or post-ceremony refunds.

We hope, however, that your arrangements will proceed without any difficulty and that your ceremony will prove both memorable and enjoyable for you and your guests.



2.7 Unable to Attend the Ceremony

If you are unable to attend the ceremony, please contact the graduation team via graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk. Please include your name and student number in this email. We will then confirm options for the postage of your certificate.

If you have made your booking via GradAttire and are now no longer able to attend you will need to contact the Grad Attire's customer service department via service@graduationattire.co.uk to request the cancellation of your booking, they will then send instructions that details how to request a refund. Grad Attire's refund policy can be found [here](#).

We hope, however, that your arrangements will proceed without any difficulty and that your ceremony will prove both memorable and enjoyable for you and your guests.

2.8 Technical Issues

3. Dress code

3.1 Academic dress

Graduation is a formal occasion; please dress in smart clothes. The Minster can get very cold in November, so graduands and their guests are advised to wear warm clothes.

Graduates may wear their national costume, if they would like to.

Graduates must be wearing a gown in order to graduate. By booking your gown you confirm your attendance, our gowns are only available via the GradAttire booking portal.

3.2 Gown hire

Graduation is a formal occasion, and academic gowns are required for all participating students and staff.

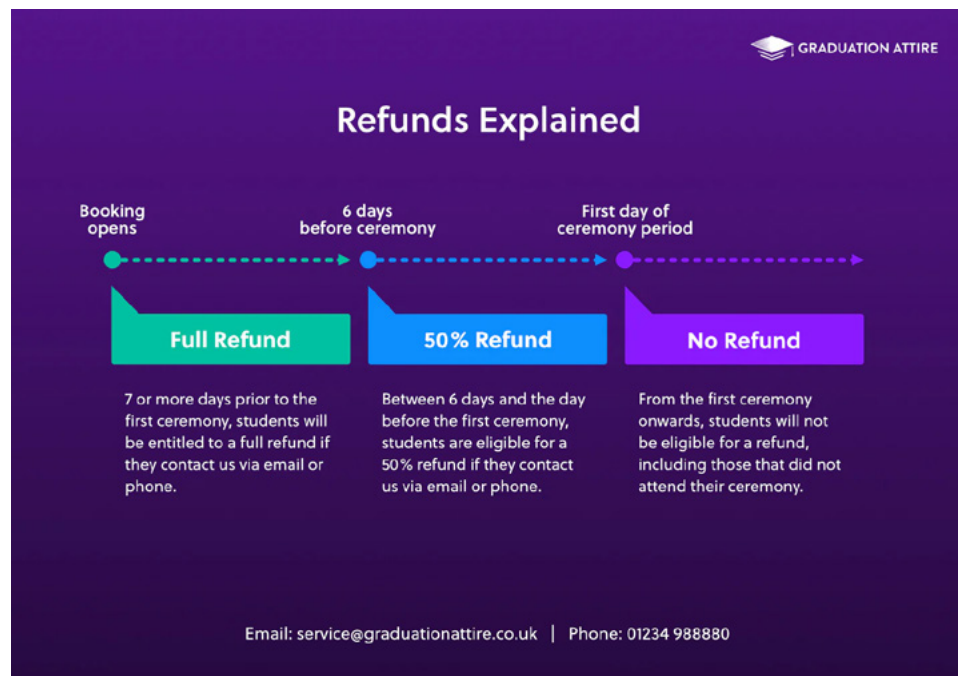
You can hire your gown through the [Grad Attire online booking portal](#) at the same time as you confirm your ceremony attendance.

Our gowns are only supplied via GradAttire, if you have any questions regarding this please get in contact via graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk

You will need to provide details of your height and head measurements. Ensure you order the correct gown - they are different for each level of award. The **final** deadline for ordering your gown is **4:00pm (BST) Wednesday 30th September 2026**, after this time our online booking portal will close.

Hired gowns will be available for collection from Quad South Hall on campus on the day of your ceremony from 7:00am and must be returned by 5:30pm. Please refer to the map at the end of this guide for directions.

For York St John University graduation ceremonies mortar boards are not worn during the ceremony but may be worn following the conferral of all awards or when processing out of the Minster.

4. Photography

4.1 Professional photography

GradAttire provide the photography for our graduation ceremonies, you can pre-book your photography package through their [online booking portal](#) at the same time as you confirm your attendance and hire your gown.

Photography packages are optional to purchase; you are not required to purchase a photography package to attend the ceremony. If you later decide you wish to purchase a photography package these will remain available for purchase via the online booking portal after the registration deadline, they will also be available for further purchase on the day of your ceremony.

Photography will take place in Temple Hall. If you have purchased or wish to purchase a professional photography package please make your way to the photography location once you have collected your gown. Please refer to the map at the end of this guide for directions.

For photography packages, all photos will be put into an online system for graduates to view within 48 hours of the graduation ceremony. All graduates with photos will then have 14 days to choose which photos they would like to be sent to our professional editing team.

Photos will then take around 6-8 weeks to be edited, printed and dispatched. All photos are dispatched over 2-3 working days once all editing is completed.

Photographers will also be present during the ceremonies to photograph every graduate receiving their award on the stage.

All photos will be put into an online system for graduates to view within 48 hours of the graduation ceremony. A physical copy of this photo will be available for purchase when you return your gown on campus.

6.2 Personal photography

There are no restrictions on photography in the Minster, but we do ask graduands and their guests to consider others when taking photographs.



5. Livestream and Video

5.1 Livestream

If you have family or friends who are unable to attend the ceremonies, they will be able to watch a livestream of the occasion. Each ceremony will be streamed live from York Minster and will be available to view on the [York St John University Events YouTube channel](#).

Although every effort is made to ensure the live webcast is available to all viewers, York St John University cannot accept liability for any loss of webcast availability. The footage will not be available for purchase.

5.2 On-Campus Screening Areas

Each ceremony will also be shown at our Students Union bar (Archie's) and coffee lounge (The Lounge) via the livestream with sound. The Students' Union will be open with full services including coffee, alcoholic drinks and food for friends and family to come and celebrate.

5.3 MyGraduationClip

In celebration of your wonderful achievement, York St John University is pleased to present you with a free, personalised clip of your special moment on stage. This can be shared with your family and friends on social media.

To access your video, we ask you to answer a few short questions about what you've been getting up to since you finished your studies. Look out for an email, a few days after you graduate from the team at MyGraduationClip who are working in partnership with our Future You Team.

6. Commemorative Graduation Brochure

6.1 Our Digital Brochure

Graduation is the time to celebrate your achievements with family, friends, and staff. To commemorate this occasion we publish a digital programme containing names of all attending graduates alongside information about the ceremonies.

Details include name and course only, NOT degree classification. If anyone graduating in person objects to the publication of their name, they should contact the graduation team at graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk before **5th October 2026**.

6.2 Your Name

Your name be listed as this appears on your student record. If you have any questions regarding this please do contact the Graduation team at graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk.

If anyone graduating in person objects to the publication of their name, they should contact the graduation team at graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk before **5th October 2026**.



7. Arrival instructions

Arrival instructions for your ceremony will be included in an email sent to you a week before the ceremony is due to take place.

We advise you allow at least two hours to collect your gown and have your photographs taken before the start of your ceremony. Collect your gown from Quad South Hall and then make your way to Temple Hall. Please refer to the map at the end of this guide for directions.

Roads are very congested in York and car parking is in short supply. Please allow plenty of time for your journey and to negotiate the traffic in York.

7.1 Arrival Times

Ceremony 1 (Monday 16 November 2026)

Gowns and photography will be available from 10:00am. You will need to be gowned and arrive at York Minster by 1:15pm at the latest.

Ceremonies 2-9 (Tuesday 17 – Friday 20 November 2026)

For morning ceremonies, gowns and photography will be available from 7:00am.

You will need to be gowned and arrive at York Minster by 9:30am at the latest.

For afternoon ceremonies, gowns and photography will be available from 10:00am.

You will need to be gowned and arrive at York Minster by 1:15pm at the latest.

All ceremonies will last approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.

7.2. Entry to the Minster

Graduates should enter the Minster by the South Door on Minster Yard (near the Roman Column and the statue of Constantine).

Your seat number will be displayed on your e-ticket (graduates only). Please make sure that you are aware of this number before you enter the Minster so that we can show you to your seat as quickly as possible.

Guests with additional needs will be sent an email with specific information on what they should do on the day - they should bring this email with them to the Minster.

7.3 Safety and security

Please note York Minster has adopted security arrangements to keep all our visitors as safe as possible.

All guests are asked to limit any articles they bring with them to small personal handbags. Backpacks, luggage and suitcases of any description will not be permitted into the building. All visitors to York Minster may be asked to have their belongings searched by a member of the Minster Police. We are very grateful for your cooperation.

8. Seating

8.1 Graduate Seating

Graduating students will find their individual seat number on their e-ticket, this will be sent by email a week before the ceremony. When entering the Minster, graduands will be directed to their seats by the stewards. Please sit on the chair with your name and number on it.

Once you have taken your place, please remain in your seat – if your seat is empty, it will indicate you are absent, and you will not be presented for your award.

8.2 Guest Seating

Guests do not have pre-allocated seats; guests' seats are available on a first come first served basis. Guests should follow instructions from the stewards on where to sit. Please note that in larger ceremonies there are overflow seating areas in the Minster which do not have a direct view of the stage but will have screens to broadcast the ceremony.

If your guests have any additional requirements in regard to seating and/or may need any assistance during the ceremony please contact the **Graduation team**.

All seats have extra leg space to ensure guests are as comfortable as possible. Guests should remain in their seats until directed to leave the Minster by a steward after the ceremony.

York Minster can get very cold in November; therefore, we recommend that guests dress as warmly as possible for the ceremonies.

8.3 Babies and Children

The University aims to make its graduation ceremonies as welcoming as possible, but the formal nature and duration of the ceremonies may make them unsuitable for babies and small children.

All children that require their own seat must have their own ticket, if babies and small children under 5 years old can sit on guest's knees they do not need a ticket.

Any children attending graduation **must** be accompanied by an adult other than the graduating student as guests and graduating students do not sit together.



9. During the Ceremony

The ceremony will be declared open, and the academic procession will make their way to the stage.

At the appropriate time, you will be directed onto the stage where your award will be conferred. A photograph of you crossing the stage will be taken by the Grad Attire official photographer. After you exit the stage you will collect your certificate and then be directed by university staff back to your seat.

Once the ceremony is declared closed the academic procession will leave the Minster through the South Transept doors. The stewards in charge will direct new graduates to join the procession at the appropriate moment, out through the South Transept doors, and into the Minster Piazza - where you should wait for your guests to re-join you.

Guests should remain in their seats until directed to leave the Minster via the Northwest door.

10. Accessibility

10.1 York Minster

The entrance points at the Minster for both graduates and guests are accessible for wheelchairs. If you or any of your guests require a wheelchair space or have any additional requirements, please indicate this when you register on the Grad Attire booking portal.

If you have any questions about accessibility, please email the [graduation team](#).

10.2 Additional medical requirements

Should you or your guests have any additional requirements you feel we should be aware of, please indicate these when you register on the [GradAttire booking portal](#). We will then ensure suitable arrangements are made for you or your guests during the ceremony. This information is held securely and only shared with those involved in the running of the ceremony.

If you are unsure if this pertains to you, please email the [graduation team](#).

11. Relaxed Graduation

York St John is committed to creating a safe and inclusive space for everyone, and this includes those attending our Graduation ceremonies.

Graduation is a time to celebrate your achievements with your family and friends; however, we understand that some students may find attending their graduation ceremony overwhelming.

Our relaxed graduation experience is designed for anyone who might feel more comfortable in a relaxed setting, including, but not limited to, students and guests with learning difficulties, autism, social anxiety, or sensory processing difficulties. All Academic Schools are included as part of the celebrations, and it's open to everyone who is eligible to attend graduation in November 2026. We plan to host this ceremony in our beautiful Chapel of St John the Evangelist on campus during the same week in November that ceremonies take place in York Minster.

If you would like to transfer your graduation to the relaxed experience, please complete our **interest form** by no later than 4:00pm Wednesday 30th September 2026.

The purpose of this form is to register your interest in attending our relaxed graduation event. At this stage this is only an expression of interest, if you later decide you wish to attend the ceremony at York Minster this will not impact your attendance in anyway.

Please note if you wish to attend either ceremony you should still go ahead and book your gown and guest tickets for the graduation ceremony you have been invited to. This confirms your attendance and lets the Graduation Team know you are due to attend. After the registration deadline (4:00pm 30th September) we will contact you with further details and if you do wish to attend the relaxed graduation event we will make arrangements, your GradAttire booking will remain intact. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact our graduation team.

12. Certificates

12.1 Your Award Certificate

Your award certificate will be available for collection during your graduation ceremony. After you cross the stage you will be directed to exit and return to your seat. Our certificates team will be based off-stage, please collect your certificate before your return to your seat.

12.2 Partnership Graduates

If you are a graduate of one of our partnership institutions, they will issue your certificate to you directly. This will not be available to collect on the day of the ceremony.

12.3 Graduating in Absentia

If you are unable to attend the ceremony, please contact the graduation team via graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk. Please include your name and student number in this email. We will then confirm options for the postage of your certificate.

If you have recently changed address, please update this via the [e: Vision homepage](#).

If we do not receive contact from you we will send an address check email shortly after the ceremonies have taken place. We require confirmation of your current postal address before we can post your certificate to you.

If you have any questions regarding this, please contact our [graduation team](#).

12.4 Prize Certificates

At our graduation ceremonies the University presents a number of prizes to celebrate student achievements.

All prize winners will be contacted before the ceremony to notify them of the award. If you are awarded a graduation prize certificate this will be included alongside your award certificate, this will be provided in a YSJ certificate display folder.

12.5 Digital Certificate and Transcript

We work in partnership with GradIntelligence (also known as GradIntel) to provide you with official digital proof of your results (interim transcript) and award (final transcript and certificate).

Students who graduated since July 2023 have access to a digital copy of their certificate via GradIntelligence. Digital certificates become available in GradIntelligence following the University Assessment Board that your award has been conferred at.

All documents bear the signature of the University's Academic Registrar and the Vice Chancellor. These documents are tamper proof and can be shared with anyone you choose, as verification of your achievements.

You will receive an email asking you to register with GradIntelligence which will enable you to complete the activation process and access your digital documents.

When you activate your account you must create your own GradIntelligence username and password. You can continue to use these to log in to GradIntelligence after you have left the University, we recommend you register using your personal email address and not your York St John address.

13. Useful Information

13.1 Visas for Overseas Students Attending the Graduation Ceremonies

It may be necessary for international graduates to request an invitation letter to support a visa application. We do not provide personalised visa letters for family/friends. For policy/regulatory purposes, we are not able to name guests, only the graduate we hold a student ceremony record for.

A visiting visa letter will be sent to eligible graduates within 48 hours of the original invitation, we are unable to provide this letter before this time. If you have not received this letter please contact our **graduation team**.

13.2 Travelling to York

Please see information on our **website** for how to get to York by your preferred method of transport.

13.3 Car parking

Car parking facilities are not available on campus or at the Minster.

The many public car parks in York will be signposted. Information on parking and maps of the City of York and the campus can be found on our **visitor information page**.

The long-stay car parks closest to the University are at Union Terrace, Foss Bank and St John's Street.

Please note there is a vehicle height restriction in the car parks of 6' 6".

13.4 Changes to your Ceremony (Force Majeure)

In the event of the graduation ceremony being cancelled or delayed due to circumstances beyond the University's control, we will (where at all possible) rearrange the ceremony for an alternative date but will not be liable for any losses incurred by you or your guests. Examples of such circumstances include, but are not limited to, natural disaster, acts or threats of terrorism, civil disturbance, national mourning, government actions, pandemic, industrial action, flood, fire, explosion, or the graduation venue becoming otherwise unavailable.



13.5 Data Protection

Graduates, guests and staff attending graduation ceremonies should be aware that they are regarded as public events. The names of graduates confirmed as attending the ceremony are published in an online commemorative graduation brochure of those in attendance. Details include name and course only, NOT degree classification. If anyone graduating in person objects to the publication of their personal data, they should contact the graduation team at **graduationyork@yorks.ac.uk** before **5th October 2026**

Audio and visual images of the ceremony are publicly available through a livestream broadcast of the ceremony via the internet, which includes the announcement of graduate names. There may also be local media or University photographers and videographers present at the event and, by attending, you give permission to use any general images in publications, promotional materials, advertisements, websites or any other digital media or filming authorised by the University. By attending the event, graduates and guests consent to be party to these practices. Please make yourself known on the day if you do not wish to be featured in any photography.

14. Congregation gifts

A national survey capturing the activities and perspectives of graduates was launched in December 2018.

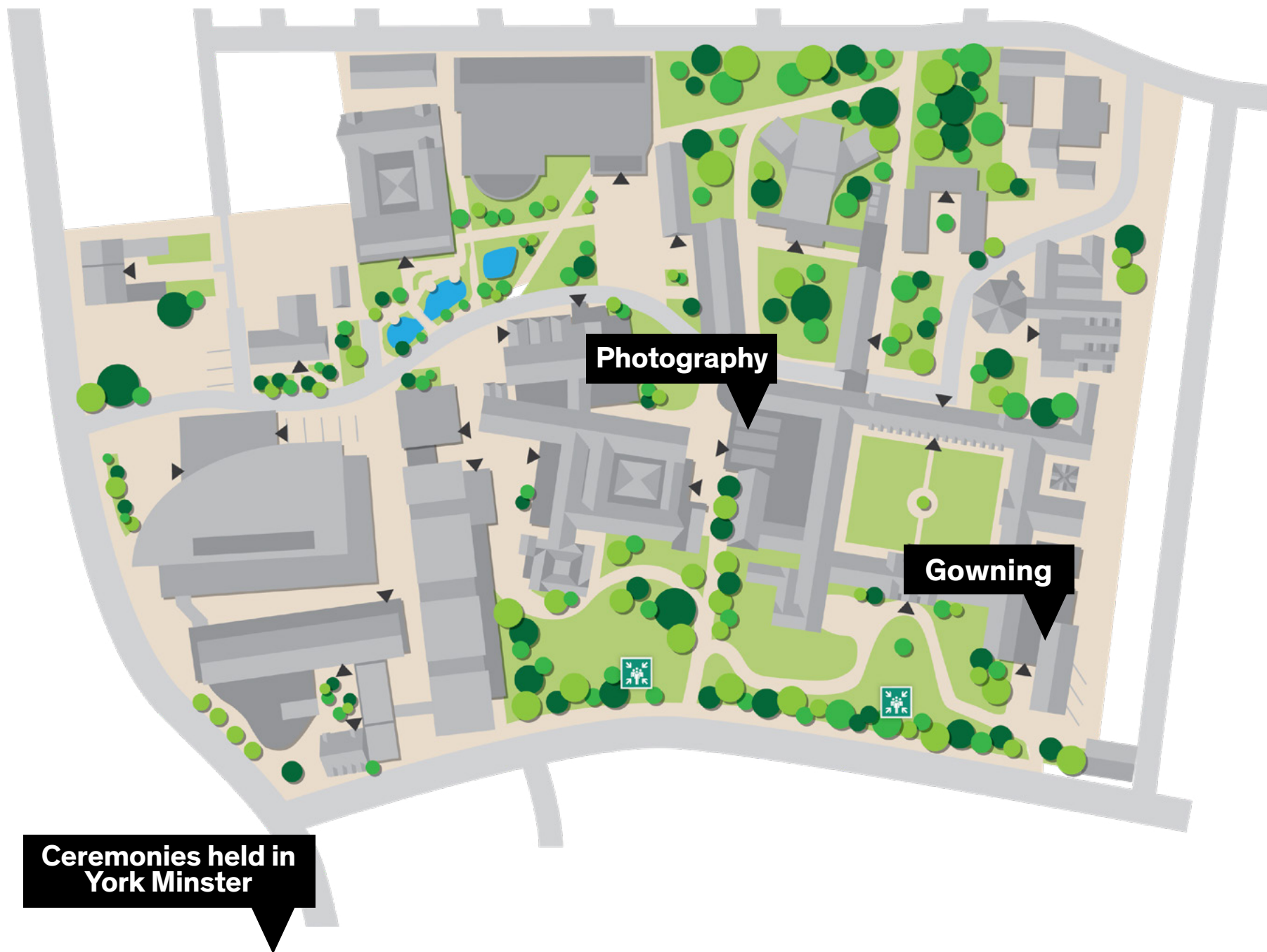
