## Creating clips



## What is BoB?

Subscribing institutions can choose and record any broadcast programme from over 60 TV and radio channels. Staff and students can catch-up on missed programmes on and off-campus (not overseas). Edit programmes into clips, create playlists and embed clips into a number of platforms e.g. PowerPoint, Mahara ePortfolio, Moodle VLE.

## Login to BoB

Click on **sign in** button

You will be asked which institution you are from; start typing **York St John University** and select **Go**.

Enter your YSJ username and password and click on **login**.

## Search

Click on the **search** tool and type in a programme title. Click on **Search options** to reveal an advanced search.

**Available now** are programmes already recorded.

Restrict search to **title only**

Select **channel option** and **date range** if known.

Click on **search** button

If **all results** is selected then there will be a mixture of **available to watch now** and **programmes to request**.

Select programme and click on **Show**

**Transcript** to jump to an exact point in the programme that you want. Clicking on the transcript will locate the video at that point.

## Make a clip

Select the programme and pause the video at the start of the clip required by playing/fast forwarding or searching in transcript.

Click on **Make Clip** button.

A timeline will appear under the video where the clip can be selected. Click and drag the vertical bars to select the clip required.

Click on **Save Clip** and give the clip a title, click **save**.

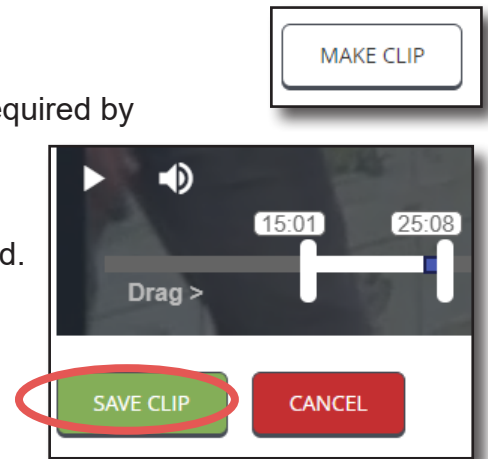

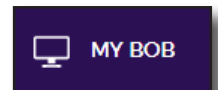

## My BoB

Click **My BoB** to view any requested items, playlists and clips.



## Add clip to PowerPoint

The best way to link a clip within a PowerPoint presentation is to hyperlink from a screen grab of the video.

In BoB, click on **Share** button underneath your clip. copy the **link**.

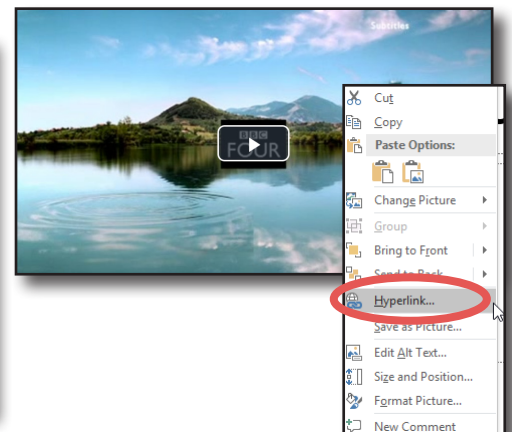
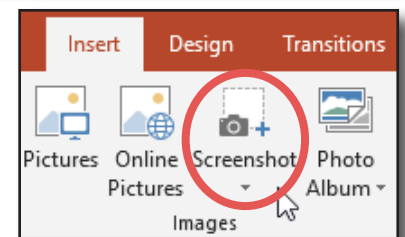
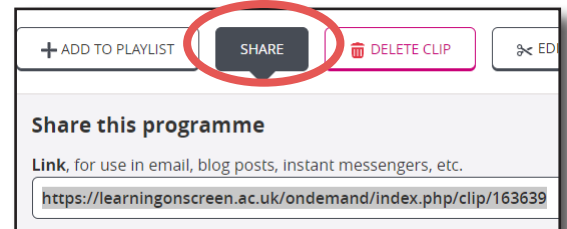
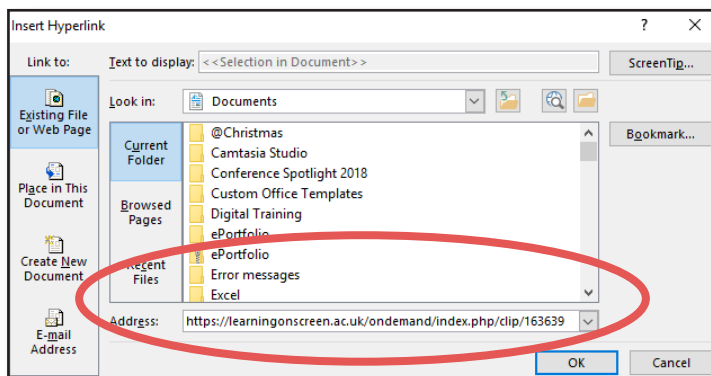
Note: Embed code does not work in PowerPoint as at 3 February 2020.

In PowerPoint, click on **Insert > Screenshot, Screen clipping**.

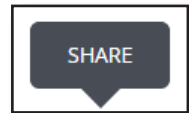
In BoB, select area, whilst image is selected in PowerPoint, right click and select **Hyperlink**. Paste link into Address field. Click **ok**.

Resize the image and select **Slide Show > From Current Slide** to test.

Note: You will need to be logged into BoB to show clip.



# Embed clip in Mahara ePortfolio

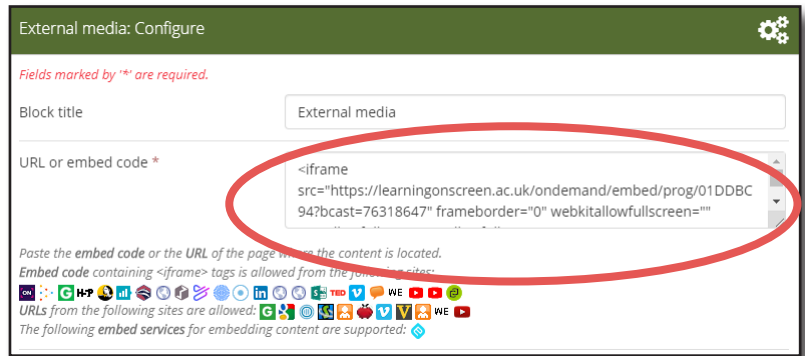
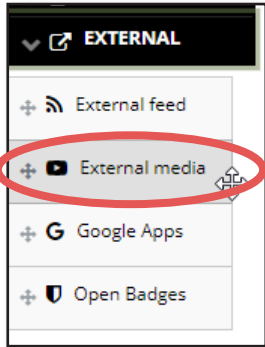


In BoB, click on **Share** button underneath your clip. Copy the **Embed** code.

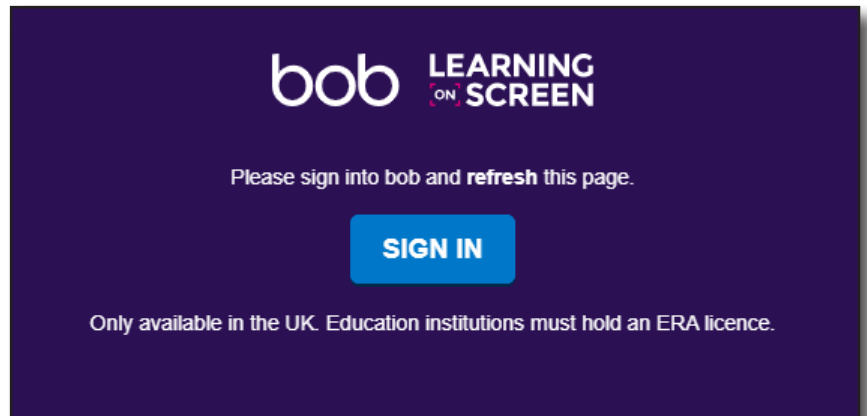
In Mahara, in editing mode, click **External > External media** > Amend title and paste in embed code. Click **Save**.

**Display Page** to save changes.

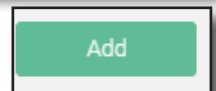
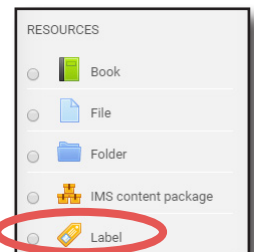
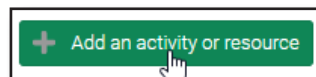


# Embed into Moodle VLE (staff)

In BoB, click on **Share** below the clip (as above).

Click on **Embed code** to select, and copy.

In Moodle, turn editing on. Select **Add an activity or resource** and choose **Label**, click **Add**.

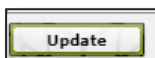


Click on **Toolbar Toggle** to display all commands.

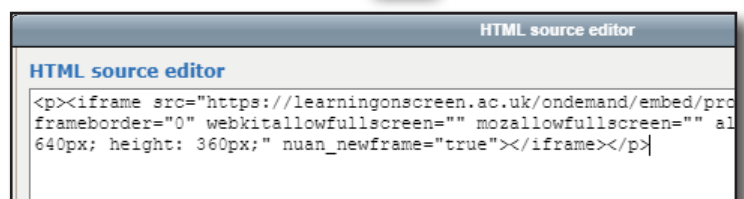
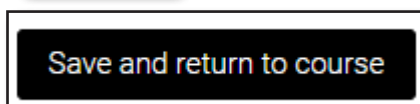
Click **Edit HTML Source** button and paste the copied iFrame code into **HTML source editor** box.



Click **Update**.



Click on **Save and return to course** to display.
