First Few Days Checklist

There is a lot to do in your first few days at York St John. Work through this checklist to make sure you don't miss anything important.

- Contact home** and let your family know you have arrived safely.
- Register online with the North Yorkshire Police** if this is a condition of your visa. You must complete Police Registration within 7 days of entry into the UK. [northyorkshire.police.uk/what-we-do/licensing/overseas-visitors/](https://www.northyorkshire.police.uk/what-we-do/licensing/overseas-visitors/)
- Collect your International Welcome Pack** from the International Student Support Team. This includes lots of goodies and useful information.
- Contact the visa team on visa@yorksja.ac.uk to **collect your BRP card** (if applicable).
- Complete your online enrolment** if you have not already done this – if possible, you should do this before travelling to the UK.
- Visit the Finance Office** to pay the remainder of your tuition fees (if applicable) and your accommodation fees.
- Find your** International Welcome & Orientation schedule in your welcome pack and make sure you attend all sessions.
- Find your academic timetable** on timetable.yorksja.ac.uk/Timetable and sign into Moodle moodle.yorksja.ac.uk/login/index.php to access course materials.
- Visit **York St John Students' Union** at ysjsu.com for this years' Freshers Week timetable and to get involved with the SU's clubs and societies.
- Open a UK bank account** (if necessary). Once you have completed enrolment and collected your BRP card (if applicable), you will need to log into e:vision to request a bank letter from the Student Information Desk. Read the Banking in the UK guide in your welcome pack for guidance.
- Register with the **Student Health Centre**. Visit the campus health centre go to www.yorkstudenthealthcentre.co.uk/ to register online.
- Get insurance** for your possessions if you live in private accommodation. If you live in University accommodation, insurance is included.
- Explore the city of York & beyond**. Have a look at the tourist guide in your welcome pack for some ideas. We will send you the Global Bulletin email each
