Use the question prompts to guide your reflective note-taking.

<b>Concrete experience:</b> What happened? What were your thoughts and feelings at the time?	
<b>Reflective observation:</b> Reflect on the experience – Why did this	
situation happen? What worked well	
and what didn't work? Why did I	
respond the way I did? How does this	
link to my skills and knowledge?	
Abstract conceptualisation: Learn	
from your experience – Why did the	
experience play out in this way? How	
could I improve? What could I have	
done differently?	
Active experimentation: Put your	
learning into practice - How can I	
apply what I have learnt to future situations?
