Memory and recall technique - Visual Glossary

A glossary can enable you to understand key terms or facts and can be used to help you memorise essential information. It can help you to **define** something, **explain** the **meaning**, and **show how it is applied** to a scenario or practice.

- **Step 1.** Write down the name of the key term, theory, idea, or technique you need to learn.
- Step 2. Beneath the name of your term, draw, sketch, or paste a picture or image that might show or be associated with this.
- Step 3. Next to each term, write a short explanation with an example or description of how this idea can be applied in your subject area.
- Step 4. Place the visual glossary above your desk or in your revision folder and go through each entry regularly or read each aloud.
